## TABLE OF FEES AND CHARGES

### SHERINGHAM CEMETERY

Tables of Fees, Payments and Sums fixed and settled by the Town Council of Sheringham acting as the Burial Authority for the District of Sheringham, with the sanction, where necessary, of the Home Office.

#### 1. FEES FOR EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF GRAVE SPACE

*(for a period of sixty years)*

To Purchase the Exclusive Right of Burial  
in an earthen grave, 9 feet x 4 feet £250.00

#### 2. FEES FOR EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS FOR ASHES PLOT:

*(for a period of sixty years)*

To Purchase the Exclusive Right of Burial of Ashes Plot  
in an earthen grave £100.00

#### 3. FEES FOR ASHES INTERMENT AT LOW WALL IN GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE

To Interment of Ashes at Low Wall Section  
– tablets are permitted 12” x 12” £120.00

#### 4. FEES FOR ASHES INTERMENT AT HIGH WALL IN GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE

To Interment of Ashes at High Wall Section  
– plaques only permitted on High Wall of  
Garden of Remembrance £120.00

#### 5. INTERMENT FEES

In a Grave or in the Garden of Remembrance.

**6. CHARGES FOR GRAVE DIGGING**

A single depth grave not exceeding 4 feet 6 inches	£270.00
A double depth grave not exceeding 6 feet	£300.00
A grave to accept an ashes casket	£100.00

**7. FEES FOR THE ERECTION OF HEADSTONES AND INSCRIPTIONS THEREON**

(a) For the right to erect and place a headstone not exceeding 3 feet in height and for the first inscription	£150.00
(b) For the right to place a permanent flower vase not exceeding 1 foot in height, width or thickness	£70.00
(c) For additional inscriptions	£50.00

Flower vases are limited to one per grave and must be placed adjacent to the headstone.

**8. FEES FOR THE ERECTION OF PLAQUES AND INSCRIPTIONS**

(a) For the right to affix a white marble plaque 12 inches x 6 inches on the Wall of the Garden of Remembrance	£80.00
(b) For the right to affix a white marble plaque 12 inches x 12 inches on the High Wall of the Garden of Remembrance and for the first inscription	£120.00
(c) For the right to affix an unpolished granite plaque 12" x 12" in strip in front of Low Wall and for the first inscription	£120.00
(d) For additional inscriptions	£50.00

**9. ADDITIONAL FEES AND CHARGES APPLICABLE UP TO AND INCLUDING GRAVE No 1814**

Small tablet, not exceeding 12" X 12", within a kerbset	£120.00

**Additional charges when Interment takes place on a Saturday, Sunday, or Public Holiday – Double Scale Fee**

**The foregoing Fees, Payments and Sums, will be doubled (with the exception of grave digging fees) in the case of any person who had not resided in the Parish of Sheringham at any time during the period of twelve months prior to death and in the case of a Stillborn Infant whose parents have not so resided.**

**Provided that a person who at the time of death was a patient in a hospital or in a Nursing or Residential Home or Hostel and who immediately preceding entering the said Hospital, Home or Hostel, was ordinarily a resident in the Parish, shall be deemed to be resident in the Parish.**

**The foregoing Regulations and Tables of Fees, Payments and Sums, were adopted by Sheringham Town Council at a meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> February 2014, but will come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014.**
